GVHA and Float Home Owners Negotiate Agreement

This holiday season sees a new spirit of conciliation and peace on the docks at Fisherman's Wharf.

Greater Victoria Harbour Authority (GVHA) and float home owners have successfully negotiated an agreement to resolve a dispute over licence terms. The agreement includes a commitment that no further legal action will be pursued, opting instead for dialogue and compromise to reach consensus.



Negotiations focused on solutions that addressed float home owners' concerns about long-term security and predictable, fair rent increases as well as GVHA's need to protect harbour assets for the long-term public interest.

The agreement includes an increase in the length of moorage licences, an agreed-upon method for appraisals and a standardized approach for establishing market rate. The new licence will take effect on April 1, 2012, under a 3-year licence term.

GVHA and the Fisherman's Wharf Community Association look forward to a long and harmonious relationship in the pursuit of maintaining Fisherman's Wharf as an amazing marine tourism destination.
