Ogden Point Landscaping

Landscaping work at Ogden Point is improving the pocket area below the Pacific Pilotage building, next to the Ogden Point Café.

A small slope was covered with a tangle of blackberry bushes and windblown tree seedlings. A low retaining wall of natural rock is being built there. A bed of wildflowers will cover the top section of the slope, with a cedar hedge to be

planted along the top.

Similar rockwork is being done to improve the James Bay Anglers boat launch site. The launch area will also receive hedging and new fencing.
