A New Vision For CPR Steamship Terminal

Greater Victoria Harbour Authority (GVHA) has submitted a proposal to see the CPR Steamship building re-established as a key marine transportation and tourism hub.

GVHA's comprehensive plan would see all four levels of the historic CPR terminal re-tenanted, with the iconic Rattenbury landmark restored to its former grandeur. It would be the first phase of a wider development plan for the PCC-owned Belleville Street properties, which could also see an integrated ferry terminal in the Inner Harbour.
