Last cruise ship of the season

Holland America Line's Oosterdam called at Ogden Point at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, October 5, 2011. Its 3 p.m. departure will mark the end of another successful season at Canada's busiest cruise port-of-call.

During the 2011 cruise season, Ogden Point was visited by more than 435,000 passengers. The deep-sea terminal saw a total of 206 ship calls, with 5 additional calls cancelled due to adverse weather. The season's highlights included the arrival of the 4 millionth passenger on August 18 and the first ever visit of a Disney cruise ship to a British Columbia port.



A plan for Fisherman's Wharf

Consultation for the Fisherman's Wharf facility plan and marina development strategy is well underway. CitySpaces Consulting is leading the preparation of the plan and is receiving and sharing information through the [plan website](#).

The project team will be presenting at the next James Bay Neighbourhood Association meeting on Oct. 12, 7 p.m. at 234 Menzies Street.

The plan will lead to an application for rezoning to the City of Victoria, targeted for spring/summer of 2012.

Cleaning cargo ships

Bulk cargo carriers Little Prince and Pos Glory recently occupied the deep-water berths at

Ogden Point.

Longshoremen were scrubbing the vessel holds before they take on cargoes to keep dirt and sediment out of the new loads. These carriers transport bulk goods like sulphur, grain, coal, ore and cement.



Cleaning cargo ships is one of many marine industrial activities that take place at Ogden Point. Yacht shipping and cable storage also occur at the terminal.

Auxiliary Coast Guard to Ogden Point

The freshly painted garage at the foot of the Ogden Point breakwater will serve as a temporary facility for Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary (Pacific) Unit 35.

GVHA is sponsoring the Victoria Marine Rescue Society's use of the garage to store rescue equipment and prepare for operations. The society will continue to moor rescue vessels at the adjacent Pacific Pilotage docks below the breakwater.
