The GVHA offers the opportunity for artists and performers to share their craft in the heart of the city. Artists are permitted to show and sell original, self-made artwork and are encouraged to make their art on-site. Two-hour sets are available for unplugged buskers, and forty-five minute show slots are available for family-friendly juggling performances at the Jugglers' Pitch on the lower causeway.

Venues include designated spots at the Inner Harbour lower causeway, Fisherman's Wharf, the Wharf Street pier, and Ship Point during the Night Market.
